

BURNING PERMIT

This permission is subject to the following conditions:

1. Application for open burning shall be submitted in writing at least 10 days before the fire is set. Ohio Fire Code, Section F-403.4.1
2. The fire is consistently attended by a competent person until such fire is extinguished. Ohio Fire Code, Section F-403.7
3. A connected fire hose or other fire extinguishing equipment is readily available for use. Ohio Fire Code, Section F-403.7
4. The location for any open burning shall not be less than 50 feet from any structure, any provisions made to prevent the fire from spreading to within 50 feet of any structure. Fires in approved containers shall be permitted, provided that such fires are not less than 15 feet from any structure. Ohio Fire Code, Section F-403.5
5. The fire officials shall prohibit open burning that will be offensive or objectionable due to smoke or odor emissions when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fire hazardous. Ohio Fire Code, Section F-403.4.3
6. Ceremonial fires are limited to 5 feet x 5 feet x 5 feet in dimension and shall not burn longer than 3 hours in duration. Ohio Fire Code, Section F-403.8
7. Fuel for a ceremonial or bonfire shall consist only of seasoned dry firewood and shall be ignited with a small quantity of paper. The fire shall not be utilized for waste disposal purposes, and the fuel shall be chosen to minimize the generation of air contaminants. Ohio Fire Code, Section F-403.8.1
8. Open burning shall not be utilized for waste disposal purposes, shall be of the minimum size for the intended purposes, and the fuel chosen to minimize the generation and emission of air contaminants. Ohio Fire Code, Section F-403.6

Application for the permit shall contain, as a minimum, information regarding the purpose of the proposed burning, the nature and quantities of material to be burned, the date which such burning will take place, the location of the burning site, and the on-site fire extinguishing equipment to be provided.

The issuing of this permit is under the authority of the Ohio Fire Code and does not release the person to which it is issued from any liability for damages such fire may cause.

Permits are not required an outdoor fire utilized to cook food for human consumption.

Permits are required for approval for providing heat for outworkers, prevention or control of disease or pests and bonfires.

All permits are subject to the Zoning Requirements of the Codified Ordinances of Wooster, Ohio.
