ORDINANCE NO. 2014-37

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION REGARDING WAGES, BENEFITS AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, representatives of the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association have met and negotiated with representatives of the City administration regarding wages, benefits and terms and conditions of employment for two bargaining units: the police officers, and the sergeants and lieutenants; and

WHEREAS, these negotiations have produced a mutually acceptable agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with representatives of the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association regarding wages, benefits and terms and conditions of employment for two bargaining units, the police officers, and the sergeants and lieutenants, in accordance with the summary of terms attached hereto. This agreement will set forth all provisions relative to wages, benefits and terms and conditions of employment to which the parties have bargained and agreed for the term specified therein.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance occurred in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department or division; and for the further reason that prompt action is necessary to provide a new agreement prior to the expiration of the existing agreement on December 31, 2014; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of the Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
