VI. NEW BUSINESS

1. First Reading - Ordinance No. 2005-33 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an annexation agreement with the Ohio Agricultural Research and Development Center, and authorizing the Director of Law to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect it, and declaring an emergency. (Ulbright)
2. First Reading - Ordinance No. 2005-34 authorizing the Mayor to execute an easement for an encroachment upon the public right-of-way, and declaring an emergency. (Ulbright)
3. First Reading - Ordinance No. 2005-35 amending various sections of Part Thirteen, Building Code, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Wooster, Ohio, to update the Building Code. (Buytendyk)
4.
