Street Maintenance

Paving

No streets were paved in 2011.

Asphalt

This operation extends the life of the roads and includes; cold patch, hot patch, alleys, water patch, curb construction, driving streets, and miscellaneous.

Concrete

Pavement and sidewalk repair.

Highway Work

The Dix Expressway requires regular maintenance to keep it safe for travelers. This maintenance includes cleaning, spraying, patching, signage, lighting, painting, guardrails, and reflective pavement marking.

• Street Cleaning

The City's streets are swept at least twice during the year. Extra sweeping is added every Friday morning from Memorial Day through Labor Day.

Miscellaneous

Miscellaneous functions may include parts pickups, carpenter shop, body shop, and welding shop needs.

Snow Removal

Prep work and salting. Other winter related functions include plowing snow, erecting snow fence, and removing snow from downtown parking lots.

Leaf Collection

Prep work, loads, gas, total man hours, cost per load, and Paradise Lawn.

Vehicle Maintenance

This operation is responsible for the maintenance and repair of all City's vehicles and various equipment used throughout the City. This maintenance includes oil changes, brakes, engine and transmission rebuilds, and diagnosis of electronic systems. In addition, custom fabrication and welding is performed when needed.

Community Services

The hanging of flags and or holiday decorations as well as setting up for downtown events such as Woosterfest.

Traffic Control and Electrical needs

Duties of the traffic control maintenance include maintaining traffic and school zone lights, sign making and repairing, painting of center lines and crosswalks, installing thermoplastic for crosswalks, and community service.

Storm sewer

Includes cleaning inlets, ditching, repair, pipe installation, and water hydrants.

Sanitary Sewer

Includes sewer repairs, manhole work, water leaks and breaks.

Parks

Maintenance of Soccer fields and the city parks.

Shade Tree

Urban Forestry

Manages calls and performs regular tree maintenance throughout the city.
