

## Wooster Water Utilities Water Tank Information




**Did you know..... that Wooster Water Utilities maintains and operates 8 elevated and ground water tanks in varying sizes and strategic locations in the distribution system?**



A water tank in our system serves to ensure a consistent water capacity and pressure during the production and demand cycle in the distribution grid. Drinking water is delivered to the tanks by various pumps and pipes throughout the system. The height and location of a tank is specifically designed to provide water pressure in the system for specific areas. Without an elevated tank, pumps would have to operate constantly to ensure sustaining service. The use of tanks allows for efficient treatment and delivery of water. An additional benefit, the towers serve to provide water in a moments notice during an active fire.



At any given time the tanks share a combined capacity of 6.75 million gallons with a similar daily production capacity at the Drinking Water Facility. On average, daily water demand in Wooster is under 3 million gallons per day and the tanks provide a great buffer to meet any service demands. Water tanks are pivotal in the system to ensure excellence to our customers taps everyday.



The Drinking Water Facility is staffed every day of the year with talent and technology to provide an essential resource to our customers. The treatment facility, pump stations and tanks are equipped with back up power sources to reduce the potential of service interruptions. Safe, reliable and excellent water quality service to our customers is our daily mission. In all weather and in all situations we are here to serve. All of our staff has taken the solemn oath to be stewards of public health. Our nature is resilience, our drive is reliability.
