Wooster Water Utilities Drinking Water Treatment



Did you know . . . that to ensure excellent quality Drinking Water to our customers greater than 15,000 tests are analyzed every year?



Talent and technology is the backbone of continuous drinking water to the citizens of Wooster. Every day and every hour of the year our talented individuals and infrastructure ensures quality drinking water to you.

Water Sources and Treatment Techniques: The Wooster Drinking Water Facility was commissioned in 1998 located at 1020 Old Columbus Road. Water is pumped from underground well sources. The well system consists of nine wells in two separate well fields. The well fields pump from the sand and gravel buried valley aquifer underlying the confluence of the Upper Killbuck Creek and Apple Creek. The aquifer is covered by 15 feet of low-permeability material, which provides protection from contamination in

some areas and little protection in others. The facility is classified by the Ohio EPA as a Class III operation. The treatment process includes ground water sources, coagulation, flocculation, iron removal, softening, sedimentation, VOC removal, recarbonation, filtration, disinfection, and solids handling.

The 2019 Wooster Water Quality Report is now available for our customers.

In 1996, the U.S. Congress amended the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) that included provisions requiring that all community water systems deliver to their customers an annual water quality report. The Water Quality Report or Consumer Confidence Report summarizes annual efforts of the City to comply with State and Federal Drinking Water Regulations. The Report includes data and test results relative to water production. The Report also includes helpful information about our Source Water Protection Plan, How Water Meters Operate, Leak Detection, Backflow Prevention and other helpful information for our customers.
