

LEGAL NOTICE

Sealed bids will be received by the City Engineer on behalf of the Director of Administration, City of Wooster, State of Ohio, at the office of said City Engineer, 538 N. Market Street, Wooster, Ohio, 44691 until twelve o'clock noon, Thursday, October 6, 2022 for the **2022 SANITARY SEWER LINING PROJECT** in accordance with the specifications on file in said office.

Project Description: This project consists of approximately 3,245 feet of 8", 10", and 12" cured-in-place sewer pipe rehabilitation, approximately 411 feet of sewer main sealing by chemical grout, and approximately 44 service lateral reinstatements.

Project Cost: The Engineer's estimated construction cost for this project is \$163,000.

Project Completion Date: March 31, 2023.

Each bid must contain the full name of every person or company interested in the same, and be accompanied by a bidding bond or a certified check in the amount of 10% of the bid price as a guaranty that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and its performance secured OR provide a contract bond for 100% of the bid amount.

Copies of the contract documents are on file in the office of the City Engineer, City of Wooster, Ohio and are available for inspection by prospective bidders by appointment in the office or on the city's bidding information webpage <https://www.woosteroh.com/engineering/bidding-information>. Bidders must register and pay for the bid documents (\$10.00), none of which is refundable, through the city's ViewPoint website. The bid documents book, plans, and videos (all on USB) can be shipped via FedEx, UPS, or picked up at the office of the City Engineer. Bidders must be registered for their bids to be considered.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Wayne County and the City of Wooster, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders are required to use the forms which will be furnished on application.
